## Checklist for OER Accessibility

ORGANIZING CONTENT
<ul> <li>□ Contents is organized under headings and subheadings</li> <li>□ Headings and subheadings are used sequentially (e.g. Heading 1, Heading 2, etc.)</li> </ul>
IMAGES
$\hfill\Box$ Images that convey information include alternative text (alt-text) descriptions of the image's content or function.
$\hfill \Box$ Graphs, charts, and maps also include contextual or supporting details in the text surrounding the image.
$\square$ Images do not rely on colour to convey information.
□ Images that are purely decorative contain empty alternative text descriptions. (Descriptive text is unnecessary if the image doesn't convey contextual content information).
TABLES
☐ Tables include row and column headers.
☐ Table includes title or caption.
☐ Table does not have merged or split cells.
$\square$ Table has adequate cell padding.
WEBLINKS
☐ The weblink is meaningful in context, does not use generic text such as "click here" or "read more".
$\square$ Weblinks do not open new windows or tabs.
$\hfill\Box$ If weblink must open in a new window, a textual reference is included in the link information.
MULTIMEDIA
<ul> <li>□ A transcript has been made available for a multimedia resource that includes audio narration or instruction. Transcript includes:</li> <li>• Speaker's name</li> </ul>

- All speech content
- Relevant descriptions of speechDescriptions of relevant non-speech audio

HEADINGS AND SUBHEADINGS
$\hfill\Box$ Captions of all speech content and relevant non-speech content are included in the multimedia resource that includes audio synchronized with a video presentation.
$\hfill\square$ Audio descriptions of contextual visuals (graphs, charts, etc.) are included in the multimedia resource.
FORMULAS
☐ Formulas have been created using MathML.
$\hfill\Box$ Formulas are images with alternative text descriptions, if MathML is not an option.
FONT SIZE
$\square$ Font size is 12 point or higher for body text.
$\square$ Font size is 9 point for footnotes or end notes.
□ Font size can be zoomed to 200%.
